## Lakeside Lodges & Fishing Lakes





**Lower Lakes** offers holidays for anglers of all abilities, and is not only perfect for families who might want to enjoy the angling, nature walks, lakeside picnics, but also for the dedicated angler and specimen hunter, in the most stunning setting, staying in luxurious lakeside lodges.

The large eight-acre lake, Lodge Lake is the centrepiece of the angling complex. It offers ample private pegs in between the reed beds, flag iris and reed mace, and apart from the water lilies the lake is relatively weed free - the lake is simply ideal fish-catching territory, with varying depths and shelves, reaching a maximum depth of 17 feet.

The smaller 1-acre lake, Iris Lake, is perfect for the youngsters and beginners; there are several secluded fishing stations along the naturally reed-lined bank, and the water achieves depths of up to 7 foot with many varying shelves and fish-catching features.

The numerous fish waiting to be caught within Lower Lakes are varied: there are Common, Mirror, Leather and Ghost carp. Carp of over 20lb have been caught but almost certainly there are bigger ones to be found. Quality Roach, Bream, Rudd, fine Tench and hard fighting Perch, even large shoals of Gudgeon can add to the enjoyment of a days angling.

Many methods can be adopted in catching these fin perfect fish, such as traditional waggler fishing; stick float, swim feeder and the pole can be a deadly technique in securing a successful day and a net full. For the specimen carp hunter, the more modern and innovative Carp fishing techniques can work equally as well, such as the hair rig and bolt rig fished boilie and method fishing. In the spring and summer stalking for the carp with floating baits is a very exciting way of catching these hard and wild fighting fish.

Baits are always a personal choice, but Sky and Discovery channel-angling presenter Andy Nicholson has discovered that the traditional baits, like maggot, jokers, blood worm, corn and red worm work very well on Lower Lakes. However he has also had great success with the successful soft new pellets and of course the many flavoured boilies available. Ground baits preferred are the brown bread crumb, laced with hemp and chopped worm, feeding little and often.
